

Through a year of significant changes, the staff of SPPL stayed the course. Several received long service awards of 5, 10, and 20 years. Innovative Programming

SPPL continued to offer an abundance of programming for all ages, including several innovative new opportunities to support the community.

In partnership with The Alberta Library and Social-Ability UK, SPPL became one of the only Canadian sites to pilot The Happiness Programme, an interactive projector system combined with a structured, staff-led program to offer engaging activities for those living with cognitive and physical care needs.


Bhante Suseela, the Spiritual Director and Chief Resident Monk of the Alberta Insight Meditation Centre, introduced mindfulness meditation and breathing techniques to visiting classes of school children and in the Mindfulness for Daily Living series for adults.

In partnership with the United Way, SPPL received 750 Kid Kits to distribute to local families with children aged 0-5. Kid Kits contain early childhood development resources for parents to use with their children.

Kids put on their safety goggles and tool belts and got to work! Building birdhouses, taking apart old computers, assembling robots, crafting with beads and constructing Lego skyscrapers: working with their hands in the library opened a whole new dimension of learning and engagement.


