Stony Plain Public Library is hiring a Student Library Assistant. Preference will be given to students in grades 10-12 in the 2024/2025 school year.

Candidates must be eager to serve all members of the public. Duties will include circulating library items, registering new library patrons, and answering reference questions. You will assist the public with computer technology and support in a professional and respectful manner. This position involves standing and walking for most of the shift.

You must have great communication skills, familiarity with a wide range of technology, and a willingness to learn.

This position is usually 1-3 shifts a week at a rate of \$15.00 per hour. The option to pick up more shifts will be available in summer months.
