eResources

Audiobook Cloud streaming audiobooks allow you to listen online at your convenience. There are over 1,000 titles for adults, children and teens, including fiction, nonfiction, classics and Spanish language audiobooks. No downloading necessary.



NoveList K-8 is a readers' advisory tool, students and teachers can access over information on fiction and nonfiction titles aimed at the K-8 audience, complete with full text reviews. It also offers hundreds of reading lists, book talks, award lists, and teachers' resources.



Downloadable movies, music, television shows, audiobooks, eBooks and comic books. Hoopla has raised the limit of items you can check out to 10 a month. In order to provide more content to patrons while we are sheltering at home, hoopla Digital has curated the hoopla Bonus Borrowers Collection. Borrowers will be debited ZERO Borrowers when they borrow any of the included titles!



With over 600 titles and reading levels from grades 3-8, TumbleBookCloud Junior is a great option for adventurous young readers who wish to go beyond the picture book collection in TumbleBookLibrary! CURBSIDE PICKUP

Quarantine sure is easier with a good book to keep you company and that's why we are offering curbside delivery of holds until the library is fully open to our patrons. While we currently are not allowing patrons into the building to browse our shelves, we'll still do our best to make sure you can get something great to read, watch, or play.

New! Patrons are able to request Spruce Grove Library items to be picked up and returned at Stony Plain Library.

Hours of operation: Monday – Friday 9:30am-4:30pm

1. Maximum 10 items/card
2. Only items, currently in, from Stony Plain Public Library and Spruce Grove Library
3. Return items in the drop box which is only accessible during hours of operation.

Our hours are limited, our staff is limited, and we can't get items from other libraries, but we won't let that stop us!

To get items you have a few options:

1. Go to tracpac.ab.ca to look for items currently available at the Stony Plain Public Library or Spruce Grove Library.
2. If you're not sure how to look for items at the Stony Plain Library you can [watch the video](#) on our website. You cannot place holds in TRACpac at this time. Email us a list of items and we'll contact you when your items are ready to be picked up.
3. Ask us for a GRAB BAG. Just let us know by email or phone what you want, for example 5 True Crime books or 10 Historical Fictions and we'll pick a selection for you.
4. Email or phone(780-963-5440) with a list of titles and we'll check the shelves for you.
5. Get items directly from the Spruce Grove Public Library by placing a request with their [Curbside Holds Pickup](#).

We strongly suggest that you wash or sanitize your hands before and after picking up your library items. We have quarantined items for 72 hours to help minimize risk and for added safety you can let the items sit for 24-72 hours before handling them at home. We won't be charging late fees until we reopen.
